Pupils will develop their understanding of the context of Dickens' novel, of the plot and of characterisation. The assessment will focus on character analysis that pupils have studied in class.</p> <p>They will work on the knowledge from HT2 on Aristotle's theory of persuasion.</p>	60 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20 marks based on knowledge from Oliver Twist and from HT2- 'Aristotle's Theory of Persuasion' • 30 marks for the character and extract analysis. Pupils will have studied the given extract in depth in class.
