

Dear Parents/Carers,

Following Assessment Point 2 (AP2), we are increasing opportunities for **Year 10 pupils to practise exam-style mathematics questions** as they continue their preparation for GCSE Maths.

Regular exam practice helps pupils become familiar with the format and difficulty of GCSE questions, while also developing key exam skills such as interpreting questions carefully, showing clear working and managing time effectively.

Each Friday, pupils are set **maths homework on Method Maths**, an online platform that allows them to complete past papers and exam-style questions. The platform provides **instant feedback**, helping pupils identify strengths, areas for improvement and the grade they are currently working at.

To ensure all pupils keep up with their exam preparation, we have been monitoring homework completion. From now on, **any pupil who has not completed their homework will attend a catch-up session on Monday**. Maths staff will supervise and support pupils during this session so they can complete the work and remain on track.

If your child is required to attend, **you will receive a text message on Monday morning** to inform you.

We would greatly appreciate your support in encouraging your child to complete their homework each week. If the homework has not been completed, please ensure they attend the catch-up session.
