Key Vocabulary

Graffiti – Words or drawings painted or stencilled on public buildings

Stencils – A thin sheet of card or plastic with a shape or letters cut out of it.

Street Art – Artwork that is created in a public space, typically without permission

Artist Case Study – A presentation of facts about a chosen artist, which should also include images of their work and your own opinion and response to their work

Banksy – World famous graffiti artist who creates elaborate designs using stencils often with anti – establishment messages



Fabric Printing

Textile printing is the process of applying colour to fabric in definite patterns or designs.

Digital textile printing is often referred to as direct-to-garment printing (DTG printing), or digital garment printing. It is a process of printing on textiles and garments using specialized or modified inkjet technology. Inkjet printing on fabric is also possible with an inkjet printer by using fabric sheets with a removable paper backing.

Types of repeat pattern:
