Understanding Health and Safety procedures in the textiles classroom

Recognising natural and man-made fibres and understand the different properties

Developing an understanding of how to operate a sewing machine, thread a spool and sew straight lines, curves and corners accurately and safely

HEALTH & SAFETY

JUGGLING BALLS

Building on skills learnt in term 1 and term 2 to construct juggling balls and decorate by adding applique and embroidery.

Circus juggling balls project:

Generating annotated design ideas and working to a brief. Using research techniques to generate a range of designs.

Keyring project based on the Mexican Day of the Dead Festival:

Investigating designers and existing designs to help create a range of design ideas.

Researching different cultures to inspire design ideas and identify a solution to a problem.

Experimenting with a variety of hand embroidery stitches

DAY OF THE DEAD

Learning how to place designs into simple repeat patterns using symmetry and rotation.

Learning methods of enhancing surface decoration by quilting, applique, hand embroidery and decofoil. Understanding how to insert a keyring clasp.

GRAFFITI

Cushion/Tote Bag project based on graffiti and pop art:

Investigating designers and existing designs/artists to help create a range of design ideas.

Understanding the industrial processes of dyeing/printing fabric and the importance of colour palettes.

POP ART

Learning how to place designs into repeat patterns using symmetry and repeat styles digitally. Learning how to construct the chosen product and neaten edges using the overlocker and attach a suitable fastening.
